PUBLIC NOTICE ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE FOR VISITORS

- 1. A visitor is an individual with disabilities who does not reside in BMTA's service area.
- 2. BMTA treats as eligible for its complementary paratransit service all visitors who present documentation that they are ADA paratransit eligible in the jurisdiction in which they reside.
- 3. With respect to visitors with disabilities who do not present such documentation, BMTA requires documentation of the individual's place of residence and, if the individual's disability is not apparent, of his or her disability. Once this documentation is received, BMTA provides paratransit service to such individuals as visitors under paragraph 2 of this section. BMTA accepts as a certification the individual's statement that they are unable to use fixed route service.
- 4. BMTA will provide service to a visitor as required in this section for any combination of 21 days during any 365-day period beginning with the visitor's first use of the service during such 365-day period. BMTA does not require the visitor to apply for or receive eligibility certification from BMTA before receiving the service required by this section.
